

# 2009 Great Smoky Mountain Trout Festival Food Standards & Regulations

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## **\*\*IMPORTANT\*\* READ BEFORE SIGNING APPLICATION**

### **Dates & Times**

**Saturday, June 20, 2009 – 9:00 am – 6:00 pm**

- Set-up will be from noon to 6:00 p.m. on Friday before the show and 7:00 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. on Saturday for those wishing to set up the morning of the festival. On-site parking will be available in the festival grounds including space for cargo trailers but will not be adjacent to your booth.
- Set up and break down times will be enforced. No vehicles are allowed in the show area before the closing time.

### **Application**

- Payment must be submitted with applications. Your canceled check will be your only receipt. CHECKS RETURNED FROM THE BANK FOR ANY REASON WILL VOID YOUR FESTIVAL ELIGIBILITY AND YOU WILL INCUR PENALTY FEES.
- Each vendor is responsible for their own taxes.

### **Notification**

- Letters of acceptance or denial will be sent out within 30 days of receipt of application.
- Show directors reserve the right to deny any application without explanation. We also reserve the right to remove any vendor violating the guidelines.

### **Entry Fees & Booth Size**

Booth size needed must be indicated on the application.

July Show –                 \$150 if sent in by March 15th  
                                      \$175 if sent in after March 15th  
                                      Deadline for July show is June 15<sup>th</sup>

October Show                \$150 if sent in by June 15th  
                                      \$175 if sent in after June 15th  
                                      Deadline for October show is September 15<sup>th</sup>

- Entry fee is non-refundable once accepted. There will not be a rain date for the show should we have inclement weather.
- Should you leave before the show ends or you are a "no show", your name will be removed from our mailing list.
- Electrical outlets are available for an additional fee of \$25.00 per hookup.
- Vendor must supply extension cords.

## Rules

- Due to the limited electricity service on the festival grounds, ANYONE in need of electricity should be prepared to provide for themselves. If you have a gasoline generator that you will be using, please inform us. Water is located by the rest room building. Each booth must be self-contained and independently operated.
- Overnight camping onsite is not allowed.
- Vendors are required to dispose of their own waste products in the provided dumpster. Trash receptacles that are placed around the grounds are for the customers use and convenience. **At festival close all materials & trash must be removed from your site and placed in the onsite dumpster.** Cardboard boxes must be broken down and placed in dumpster. It is imperative that clean-up be thorough. Any vendor's assigned space left in disarray or with loose trash may forfeit their participation in any future festivals.
- **Grease and ash barrels are provided for your disposal. DO NOT dump grease or ash on festival grounds.**
- The Maggie Valley Chamber does not provide nor guarantee security for crafter booths or contents.
- Neither the Maggie Valley Chamber nor the Town of Maggie Valley will be held responsible for any damage to the property or persons participating in the shows.
